WEEKLY TRAINING SESSIONS

During the Summer (March – July), we train at Seahill. Please ensure that players do not use their team jerseys for training.

Winter training is at different locations from October until March – your team manager will confirm.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Under 6s & Girls pay £2 every week to your team Manager.

All other ages (U7 Open Age) pay £120 per season (£40 by 30th Sept, £40 by 1st Dec and £40 by 1st March)

SEAHILL (HOME GROUND)

The postcode for Seahill is CH1 6BJ. Please park in a line as close to the next car. If the car park is full, you can use the Fishing Lakes car park next door. Please do not park on the road. During match days we will have respect barriers around the pitch. Please stand behind the barrier to support your team and follow the code of conduct. Any abuse will not be tolerated. Please let the coaches' coach and the player's #playwithasmile. Encouragement and support are welcomed. If you can help out with setting up the pitch prior to the game or putting the equipment away after the game, it would be most appreciated.

Litter - Please ensure all litter is taken away with you.

Dogs – Well behaved dogs are welcome and must be kept off this pitch on leads. Please remember that children play on the pitches so do not allow your dog to foul near or on the pitch. If possible please walk your dog prior to the match in order to prevent this.

CODE OF CONDUCT/PLAYER REGISTRATION

Saughall Colts JFC operates a code of conduct to promote fair play and respect for all. CHILD PROTECTION

Saughall Colts JFC adhere to The Football Association's Child Protection Policies and Procedures. All Team Managers undergo a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check. All Team Managers attend the FA Child protection and best practice – Workshop. The Club has a Welfare Officer to advise on best practice and deal with any child protection issues

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

In case of an accident at Seahill, please call 112 or 999 first and then ask for help if not First Aid accredited. Arrange for another Manager to open the ambulance gate. The First Aid equipment is located in a green bin which will be near to the bridge. There is a defibrillator in the bin which can be used if you see someone unconscious. The defibrillator cannot shock anyone and will shout out instructions, so is very easy to use.

Respect Code of Conduct

Spectators and Parents/Carers

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game

This club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.

Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake - mistakes are part of learning
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA, league or The FA:

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club, league or County FA Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Obliged to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents.

In addition:

 The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/ or suspension on the club.
